

The Seven Trumpets of Revelation

"But unless you repent, you too will all perish." (Luke 13:3,5)

Trumpet	Description	Effect
1 (8:7)	Hail and fire mixed with blood was hurled down upon the earth	1/3 of the earth burned up 1/3 of the trees were burned up all of the green grass burned up
2 (8:8-9)	Something like a huge mountain, all ablaze, was thrown into the sea	1/3 of the sea turned into blood 1/3 of the creatures living in the sea died 1/3 of the ships were destroyed
3 (8:10-11)	A great star, blazing like a torch, named Wormwood (a very bitter herb), fell from sky on 1/3 of rivers and springs	1/3 of the waters turned bitter Many people died from the bitter water
4 (8:12)	1/3 of the sun was struck, as well as 1/3 of the moon, and 1/3 of the stars	1/3 of the day was without light 1/3 of the night was without light
5 (9:1-12)	Locusts with power like scorpions Told not to harm grass, plants, or trees Those with the seal of God protected	Not allowed to kill people Inflict torturous pain for five months People seek death but won't find it
6 (9:13-21)	4 angels bound at the Euphrates are released Army of 200,000,000 horsemen Horses heads are like lions and tails like snakes	Horses tails inflict injury Horses mouths breath fire, smoke and sulfur 1/3 of mankind killed
(10:1-11:14)	Second Interlude	Little scroll and 2 witnesses
7 (11:15-19)	Kingdom of the world becomes the Kingdom of our Lord and His Christ Ark of the Covenant seen in heaven	Flashes of lightning, rumblings, thunder, earthquake, and hailstorm from the throne Issues in the Seven Bowls of God's wrath
